Psychological features of treatment of individual property in early and preschool childhood

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Aim of research

The research **aims** to investigate the connection between child's individual property treatment and the development of his self-consciousness.

The property

1) is both material and ideal object

2) don't exists outside of social relationships

Property as a component of selfconsciousness

A number of psychologists considered individual property as a component of selfconsciousness.

W. James : property is a part of the Physical "Me"

G. Olport: inclusion of material objects to the selfconsciousness (proprium) as the "expansion of ego". The **recognition of property relationships** appears at the turn of early and preschool childhood. Preschool childhood is the age of **zealous possessiveness**.

The new formation of this period is child's psychological separation from adults and recognition of Self, and it is one of main stages of child's self-consciousness development.

It lets to conclude...

It lets to conclude that

the recognition of ownership and zealous possessiveness are connected with the child's self-consciousness development.

M.V. Osorina: "preschool child's property is not just utilitarian things but they are signs that substitute a child".

Hypothesis:

individual property is external tool which mediate a child selfconsciousness development.

On the other hand

Unadequate individual property treatment could influence negative on child's development

Individual property

Can support the development of self-consciousness Can distort the development of the personality

Empirical research

Focus group: children 2-5 years old

Aim: to investigate the connection between child's individual property treatment and the development of his selfconsciousness. Property has to be important for child not by itself, but just like a tool of self-consciousness development mediation. Investigation of child's individual property treatment (sensitiveness to the norms of ownership, possessiveness)

•Investigation of self-consciousness (selfborders, content of self-consciousness)
